Storyboard Movie Sequence Assignment

You are going to demonstrate an understanding of the design phase of film/video production, through the development of a storyboard based on a 1-minute continuous sequence from your favourite movie or web series. You must provide the 1-minute clip to the teacher for marking purposes (a link to the video, on YouTube or another site accessible from the school computers).

Your storyboard must include the following information:

- Visual Image (hand drawn)
- Shot description, including:
 - Shot Type (medium close-up, etc.)
 - Angle Type (low, etc.)
 - Camera movement (pan, dolly, etc.)
- Sound Design (Music, SFX)
- Dialogue (Breakdown of what is being said)
